RULES:

PLEASE READ ALL RULES AS THEY WILL BE ADHERED TO. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE JUDGED IF THEY DO NOT CONFORM. PLEASE FILL OUT ENTRY FORMS CORRECTLY CLASSIFYING EACH ENTRY.

1. Exhibits in Classes G-J must be made by the exhibitor within the last two years, except where otherwise stated.
2. Clubs or organizations may enter where specified only.
3. All exhibits must be in place between 8:00 AM and **11:30 AM** and exhibit sheets must be filled out and handed in by 12:00 NOON. Exhibitors must exit as doors will be locked at that time on October 14th, 2010
4. Removal time for all exhibits will be 4:00 PM Sunday. We will not be responsible after 4:00 PM Sunday. The hall will be open for viewing exhibits on Sunday from 12:00 Noon to 4:00 PM.
5. Entry Forms should be sent to Walkerton Agricultural Society, c/o Marlene Berry, Box 1497, Walkerton, Ontario, NOG 2V0. Entry Forms and tags are available from Marlene Berry, Walkerton Home Hardware, Walkerton Meat Market or Walkerton Community Centre.
6. Judging commences at 1:00 PM October 14th. Judges and Officials **only** will be allowed in the exhibit hall at judging time.
7. Entries will be judged on a point system follows:
First ----- 5 points
Second ----- 3 points
Third ----- 2 points
Fourth----- 1 point
8. All exhibitors of Specials must live within a radius of 15 miles of Walkerton.
9. Winners of specials are asked to please pick up their prizes at 4:00 PM Sunday.
10. A \$5.00 membership will be retained for 2011.
11. If there are more than 12 (twelve) entries in a section, the section will offer 2 (two) sets of prizes (excluding specials).
12. Please See General Rules.
There will only be one entry per exhibitor in any section.
